

Instructions to Authors for Resubmitting Full Text Papers

To prepare the manuscript for a final version, ready for publication, you must follow these steps. This document is similar to the e-mail authors received with the comments to your manuscript, from the reviewers.

1. Please note that your paper can only be printed if you have registered and paid the registration fee. If you are not already registered, we kindly ask you to do so at the latest, before March 1st. You may log in to the registration system here: <http://tinyurl.com/y99e49j>
2. The format of your paper are describes in the "Full text guidelines". To ensure a more consistent format of the full text papers, we did some slight changes to the original guidelines. It is thus important that all authors go though the guidelines again to adopt to the last format guidelines. The most important change is that the APA style will be used as the reference style, with one adjustment: in-text citations should never have more than two author names, otherwise use "et al." Please read carefully the **full text guidelines** before changing your text.
3. If you changed your conference abstract due to comments from the abstract reviewer, these changes should be accommodated into the full text paper also.
4. Please revise your manuscript according to the comments from the reviewers. These comments are written in your manuscript, attached as a file to this e-mail.
5. For those authors who are not native English speaking, we suggest that a proofreader go through the manuscript checking the English language.
6. When submitting the final version of your manuscript, please make sure that all field codes from reference managers and "track changes" tools are removed. You must also follow these directions when submitting:
 - a. Prepare your file with your fulltext paper in rich text format or MS word format. Filename must be "UserIdNr_FirstAuthor_Four_Words_of_Title_FINAL.doc" (e.g. "1541521_Kjendlie_How_To_submit_Paper_FINAL.doc")
 - b. Send the final version of the manuscript to bms2010@nih.no , including:
 - i. subject heading of e-mail: same as filename
 - ii. Five lines of information in the body of the e-mail (each on a separate line):
 1. UserIdNr: 7digits (from the abstract submission confirmation e-mail)
 2. Title: Your corrected paper title goes here
 3. Corresponding Author: LastName, FirstName
 4. Email: nn@dot.com
 5. Abstract Category: Identical to your submitted abstract
 6. Additional comments for the scientific committee must be written after these five lines.
 - c. Observe that full text paper submission will not generate an automatic verification of your submission. We do this manually; please allow us some time to respond.
 - d. Do not forget to ATTACH your file!!
 - e. Deadline for revision of your manuscript is ten – 10 days after you received this mail.
